

CHOW THE RULE 1. Should you apply for more than two sports, from the same college, your application for the third event shall not be considered.

2. All applicants are required to be college students.

3. All applicants are required to bring the hardcopy of their college's identity card and an identification card on the date of registration i.e., on the 13th of February, 2020. (This shall be required to attain Aparajit ID card which shall enable you to participate).

4. Instances of misconduct, indiscipline, fraud and misrepresentation shall be dealt with strictness. Such incidences will make such participant, and if needed then entire contingent/team shall be liable to be disqualified from that particular, or all the events. The decision of the organizing committee will be final and binding in this regard.

5. Substance abuse in all its forms is strictly prohibited inside the CAMPUS of Symbiosis Law School NOIDA, ALL the venues of Aparajit 2020, and ALL the accommodation and transport facilities provided by the institute for the purposes of Aparajit 2020. Any violation of this rule can make an entire contingent liable for disqualification from all the events.

6. Registration fee is non-refundable even in the instance of non-participation.



ACCOMODATION & TRANSPORT



If the contingent opts for accommodation, the amount payable for registration would be INR 3000 per contingent member. The registration fee would include accommodation from 13th of February, 2020, 12 noon to 17th of February, 2020, 12 noon.

Breakfast, refreshments during the events, transporting to and from the venue, free participation in any one event and free entry to all Symfiesta Pro Nights would be included in the price payable as the registration fee.







PRIZE WORTH: ₹20,000/-



REGISTRATION FEES: ₹3,500/- (per team)

- 1. The matches will be of 15 over-format except Semi-Finals and Final, which will be of 20 overs.
- 2. Powerplay for 15-over matches will be of 5 overs and for 20-over matches will be of 6 overs.
- 3. The Tournament shall be on the knock out basis.
- 4. All Rules as mentioned by ICC shall be followed EXCEPT as mentioned under:
 - a. The matches can be played with either White or Red leather ball.
 - b. As matches can be played with either white or red ball, Teams must carry BOTH White as well as Colored Kits.
 - c. One short pitched ball is allowed for each over.
 - d. A break of 10 minutes will be given to both the teams after an inning is over. After the end of 10 minutes, overs/runs will be deducted as per the discretion of Event Head or Umpires.
 - e. Teams shall be penalized by Umpires/Event Head for slow over rate.
 - f. The Umpires decision will final and both the teams have to adhere to it.
 - g. In case of a tie, super over will determine the winner. The teams batting second in the match will bat first in super over. The loss of two wickets in the over ends the team's over innings.
 - h. In case a tie persists after super over, the winner shall be determined as per ICC rules pertaining to super over.
- 5. The organising committee reserves the rights to change the Venue, Time, Date & Number of overs of the matches, if necessary.
- 6. In case of conflict of interest between the players or the umpires, the final decision will be taken in consultation with the event head and the umpire. That decision will be the final decision.
- 7. The teams should report 45 minutes before the scheduled matches. The teams which failed to report on time shall be penalized accordingly.
- 8. The Number of Players shall not be more than 15 players per team.
- 9. The teams may have to play 2 Matches in a day. Resting period of 45 minutes after the first match will be given.
- 10. The Fixtures released will be the final fixtures and the requests for change in timings of the match will not be entertained in any case after the release of fixtures.

FOOTBALL

PRIZE WORTH: ₹20,000/-



REGISTRATION FEES: ₹3,500/- (per team)



- 1. The teams are expected to come in proper football attire with football shoes, stockings and shin guard without which the player will not be allowed to participate.
- 2. The tournament will be organised as per the guidelines of All India Football Federation rules otherwise modified fully/partially and specified and in best interest of the players.
- 3. The tournament Committee/Referees decision will be final and binding on all in any matters.
- 4. The duration of the match shall be 25 minutes each half, with interval of 10 minutes.
- 5. The teams should report 45 minutes prior to the scheduled matches.
- 6. The number of players shall not be more than 16 players.
- 7. The team can play maximum 2 matches in a day.
- 8. The tournament shall be group stage followed by knockout stages.



BASKETBALL



PRIZE WORTH: ₹15,000/-



REGISTRATION FEES: ₹3,000/- (per team)

- 1. The tournament shall be conducted as per the BFI rules.
- 2. Players on the same team shall not wear duplicate number.
- 3. Team shall consist of 12 players, 5 players in the court at playing time.
- 4. All players should be in proper uniform.
- 5. Team must report at the playing court at least 45 minutes before the scheduled time of the match.
- 6. The referee shall have the power to make decision of any point not specifically covered in rules.
- 7. Under no circumstances protest against officials will be entertained.
- 8. No request for postponement will be entertained.
- 9. No players/manager of a participating team shall interfere with the conduct of the tournament and/or any match of the tournament and shall not enter into argument with the supervising officials.
- 10. Games will be conducted in four quarters system i.e. 7.5 minutes each for men and 5 minutes each for women.
- 11. Finals will be conducted in four quarters of 10 minutes each.

REGISTRATION FEES: ₹3,000/- (per team)



- 1. The team must consist of neither more than "10" players nor less than "6" players.
- 2. The team list must be submitted before the match starts.
- 3. No player would be allowed to play apart from the players mentioned in the Team list.
- 4. All matches will be played in sets of "3" till the finals and the finals will be played in sets of "5".
- 5. Only "2" time-out per team will be allowed each game, the duration of which will not exceed "60" seconds.
- 6. All matches at default will be played in "rotation".
- 7. Rest of the rules regarding service faults etc. would be clarified before the match starts. All the teams must seek clarification before the match starts.
- 8. Referee's decision will be final. In the case of any ambiguity the organizing committee would consult with the referees, no other team will be allowed to do so and the referees clarification will be binding.
- 9. No further arguments would be entertained and that would be considered as a part of misconduct. Referees might give decision against a team on the grounds of misconduct.
- 10. No personal sledging against the other team will be entertained during the match and the same will be treated as misconduct.

BADMINTON

REGISTRATION FEES: ₹400/- (men's single)

- 1. Each team shall consist of 2-4 players.
- 2. All the matches will be of "best of three" games of 15 points each. Only the Semifinal and Final matches would be of 21 points. The matches will be played with feather shuttles.
- 3. A toss shall be conducted and the side winning the toss shall either choose to serve or choose the side.
- 4. If the score becomes 20-all, the side which gains a two point lead first, shall win that game. If the score becomes 29-all, the side scoring the 30th point shall win that game.
- 5. Neither side shall cause undue delay to the delivery of the service. The whole shuttle shall be below the server's waist. The server shall stand without touching the boundary lines of the court. The side winning a game shall serve first in the next game.
- 6. Sides are to be changed at the end of the first game; at the end of second game, if there is to be a third game; and in the third game when a side first scores 11 points.

- 1. The 'Team' shall comprise of minimum of 2 players and maximum of 5 players.
- The number of balls for the game will be announced in the beginning of the match. Change of balls during the game shall be at the discretion of the chair umpire.
- 3. Fixture for the individual events will be as per the number of entries.
- 4. All formats will be on Knock-out basis.
- 5. The fixture will be conducted at the end of one set for both men and women.
- 6. In case of a draw the "tie break" rule shall be followed at six all.
- 7. The standard scoring pattern will be followed.
- 8. If the organizers face time constraints, they may resort to "ad-all" rules.
- 9. Players are expected to bring their own racquets.
- 10. In case of any controversy regarding scoring, the decision of the chair umpire shall be final and binding.

- 1. The teams in the 'Team Event' will consist of minimum two and maximum 4 players each.
- 2. The team event will consist of four singles and one double in A, B, AB and X, Y, XY format.
- 3. Singles event will consist of best of 3 matches till quarterfinals followed by best of 5 matches in the semis finals and the finals.
- 4. No player shall be allowed to change the racket or the rubber of the racket during the match.
- 5. All the standard rules of table tennis will be followed during the matches.
- All the matches will be played with white stag 3 star balls.

CHESS





PRIZE WORTH: ₹3,000/- (Winner) ₹2,000/- (Runer up)



REGISTRATION FEES: ₹400/-

- 1. The tournament will be played by the latest fide rules.
- 2. The tournament committee has the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason. The tournament can modify the rules at any stage.
- 3. The decision of the Arbiter shall be final and binding.
- 4. Time Control: 5 minutes + 5 seconds increment from first move.
- 5. Total number of rounds will be at least 5.
- 6. One point for winning the round and 0.5 for a draw will be awarded.
- 7. The touch and move rule will apply.
- 8. If the player opts to write the notation, the player is bound to write the whole match.
- 9. In case of a tie, a tie breaker shall be held wherein both players will play in one round of blitz.

Illegal Moves:

- 10. Two illegal moves in a match will result in lost game.
- 11.0n first illegal move by a player, the opponent player will be awarded a 2 minute increment.
- 12. Every team has to reach the venue 10 minutes prior to the scheduled match.
