Amitesh holds a vast experience in litigation and primarily specializes in Real Estate, Broadcasting, Telecommunications, Banking, Labour and Service matters. He has played instrumental role in protecting broadcasting rights of Multi Screen Media, Singapore w.r.t. Indian Premiere League from its inception i.e. 2009 and has successfully obtained John Doe Orders from Hon'ble Delhi High Court in years 2010, 2011 and 2012. Mr. Mishra has about 20 reported judgments from the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to his credit including the famous SMS Pharmaceutical Case Constitution Bench judgment where Court has laid down guidelines relating to prosecution under Section 138 of the NI Act, Kailash vs. Nanhku whereby Hon'ble Supreme Court while exercising powers under Article 141 of the Constitution allowed the courts to read "shall" as "may" in Order 8 Rule 1 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.

Hon'ble National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission appointed Mr. Mishra as Amicus Curiae in many cases where he provided his able assistance to the Commission in speedy disposal of cases. Presently, he heads the Firm, supervises strategies and represents clients at various judicial forums.
