#### Event Description

Increased globalization of business and expansion of international trade have led to a paradigmatic shift in the way International Arbitration is being conducted. With a creeping move from an absolute adhoc setup to mix of adhoc and an institutional setup, the arbitrators, arbitration practitioners and arbitral institutions have been striving to design new rules, procedures and techniques to meet the current requirements of arbitration practice to better serve the business and governments engaged in international commerce and investments. Over the last thirty years, many new techniques (such as Redfern Schedule, Emergency Arbitrators, multi-party arbitrations, Third Party Funding etc.) have been adopted by the Arbitrators and arbitral institutions to keep pace with the dynamism with which commercial trade and practice is evolving and also to make the Arbitral system more cost and time effective. The panelists would attempt to discuss the effect of shift from old classroom arbitration techniques to new techniques and concepts adopted in International Arbitration from time to time.
