***Associate Professor (Law)**

Essential Qualifications:

1. Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
2. A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
3. A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry with a minimum of seven publications in the peer reviewed/UGC listed journals and a good research score.

***Professor (Law)**

Essential Qualifications:

1. An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer reviewed/ UGC listed journals and an excellent research score.
2. A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National level institutions/industries with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.
3. Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricular and courses, and technology –mediated teaching learning process.

OR

4. An outstanding professional with Ph.D.in relevant/allied/applied disciplines from academics/research institutions/industries, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline to be substantiated with documentary evidence.

Desirable Qualifications:

1. Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology- evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
