This event not only aimed to enhance legal skills but also to instill a sense of responsibility among future lawyers to address social injustices.

Students demonstrated legal reasoning, critical thinking, and persuasive advocacy by presenting well-structured arguments. The event involved memo drafting and oral rounds, simulating real-world legal practice, and provided a platform for law students to refine their advocacy skills through engaging legal debates.


