- 4) **Foster Knowledge on Nutrition and Health:** To create awareness about the importance of proper nutrition and health care, ensuring that children understand how government schemes like Rashtriya Poshan Yojana contribute to their well-being.
- 5) **Empower Children to Recognize and Report Abuse:** To teach children how to identify and respond to inappropriate behaviour, equipping them with the knowledge to seek help in situations of abuse through discussions on the POCSO Act.

- Volunteers teach children how to set boundaries and seek help from trusted adults.

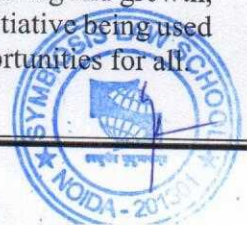

13. Description of Event (max. 250 words)

The event organized by the Legal Aid Centre in collaboration with Samarthan Foundation aimed to raise awareness among 70 to 80 underprivileged children aged 5 to 15 years on critical social issues. Through skits and interactive sessions, the event focused on educating the children about their rights and opportunities for a better future. The session on the Right to Education (RTE) Act highlighted the importance of education, explaining how it guaranteed free and compulsory education for children aged 6 to 14. Volunteers emphasized that education could break the cycle of poverty and open up opportunities for the children.

The event also addressed the issue of child labor, raising awareness about its harmful effects on children's development, education, and well-being. The children were informed about the legal protections in place to shield them from child labor and were encouraged to prioritize staying in school. The discussion helped them understand that their childhood should be dedicated to learning and growth, not work. Gender equality was also emphasized, with the Beti Bachao Beti Padhao initiative being used to inspire both boys and girls to challenge gender stereotypes and support equal opportunities for all.





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The session on malnutrition, delivered through the Rashtriya Poshan Mission, focused on the importance of proper nutrition for children's physical and cognitive development. Volunteers explained what constitutes a balanced diet and how children could benefit from government schemes like the mid-day meal program. Finally, the session on "Good Touch and Bad Touch" helped the children recognize personal boundaries, empowering them to report inappropriate behavior to trusted adults.






