1- CONCEPT NOTE:

The Legal Aid Centre at Symbiosis Law School, Noida conducts several awareness programs to sensitize the society towards different legal and social issues.

As an extension of the above initiative, I organized a legal literacy campaign on World Environment Day and World Human Rights Day.

For this I took the initiative and planted 5 Ashok trees was given. It is planned that a sum of Rs. 200 would be collected from the residents of Ansal Basera Estate at Jhansi and these trees would be planted in the appropriate season.
