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1. Concept Note -: Under the auspices of Article 39A of the Constitution. - A basic set of questions were prepared to assess the level of understanding of the students.
- Preparation was not only in English but also in Hindi so that the student remain comfortable throughout the session.
- Analytical question on number series were also given to them so that their basic standard of reasoning could be assessed.

3. Conducting the Program- The workshop was organised on 7 September 2020 in evening at 4:00 clock where there were 11 boys and 1 Girl from class 10 were sitting. The event was conducted in the activity room. The students were briefed through the means of a power point presentation which lasted around half-an- hour. This was followed by a Q&A session in which the students participated with zeal and enthusiasm. After the program there was a meeting session with the teachers.

4. Response of the audience -
