

Logging in to Kluwer IP Law

The website has the same log in page for all services. Subscribers will have to log in with their unique service specific login credentials to be able to view service specific documents. Customers with IP-based access will be logged in to their subscribed service on Kluwer IP Law automatically. **To log in to Kluwer IP Law:**

- 1. The main Login page will display when you follow the URL www.kluweriplaw.com. Note: Here, you can enter unique service
- specific login credentials. 2. Enter your **User ID** and **Password**.
- 3. Click the Login button.
- 4. You are now logged in to the specific service you are subscribed to and can access all documents contained within the database. Near the top-right of the page you will see the username next to the Log off link.

Note: Kluwer IP Law may also be accessed through IRN/Intelliconnect. Adjacent to the user ID and Password fields, separate links have been provided for IRN/Intelliconnect users.

Logging out of Kluwer IPLaw

To log out of Kluwer IP Law:

Find and click the Log off link near the top-right of the page and next to the username.

You are now logged out of the Kluwer IP Law application.

The Kluwer IP Law website is taxonomy driven, i.e. all materials in the database are grouped into one or more predefined topic categories which are browsable. We distinguish the following topic categories:

Practice Tools

About the Practice Tools Topic Category

The Practice Tools Topic is divided into various subsections: Manual IP Smart Charts ™ Manual IP Compare Jurisdictions Visser's EPC Smart Charts ™ Patent Litigation Smart Charts ™ Patent Litigation Compare Jurisdictions Trademark Litigation Smart Charts ™ Software Patents Worldwide Compare Jurisdictions

The IP Law service contains all of these. The other three services include only some of these tools.

All practice tools can be accessed from their respective links in the Practice Tools section near the top-middle of the home page and from the Practice Tools tab on the top tab menu on all of the pages.

Manual IP Smart Charts™

Manual IP Smart Charts is available in all the four services of Kluwer IP Law. To use Manual IP Smart Charts™:

- 1. Select the in the Practice Tools section or Practice Tools tab the Manual IP Smart Charts[™] link. The Manual IP Smart Charts[™] page will display in a separate window.
- 2. Select the main topic you would like to browse. You may select one or all of the main topics. Note: You may click the plus symbol to expand the categories and view the text types.
- 3. Click the Next button located at the bottom left of the page. The page Step 2: Select a jurisdiction will display.
- 4. Select a country or countries.
- Note: The countries are divided into alphabetical sections (i.e. A-C, D-F, etc).
- 5. Click the Next button. The page Step 3: Results will display.
- 6. Select either Chart View or Matrix View from the Display As: dropdown menu to display your results in Chart view or Matrix view.
- 7. The charts and matrices can be printed, saved, or exported with ease. In addition, a link to the full text of the relevant analysis, case law and/or legislation is provided.

Note: You can always return to a previous item selection screen by clicking the Prev button. You can also click Start Over button at the final item

selection screen to clear all of your selections and create a new chart.

Visser's EPC Smart Charts™

Visser's EPC Smart Charts is available in the IP Law and Patent Law services. The procedure below applies to both services. To use Visser's EPC Smart Charts ™

- 1. Select the in the Practice Tools section or Practice Tools tab the Visser's EPC Smart Charts ™ link. The Visser's EPC Smart Charts ™ page will display in a separate window.
- 2. Select the main topic you would like to browse. You may select one or all of the main topics. Note: You may click the plus symbol to expand the categories and view the text types.

- 4. Click the Submit button. The topic for the selected countries will display.
- 5. The results are presented in a summary format with links to the full text and the option to print the findings.

- 2. Select at least two countries in the Select Jurisdiction(s) column by clicking the checkbox next to the selected country.
- Select a topic in the Select Topic(s) column by clicking the checkbox next to the selected topic. Note: You can select more than one topic.
- 4. Click the Submit button. The topic for the selected countries will display.
- 5. The results are presented in a summary format with links to the full text and the option to print the findings.

Note: You can clear the selected jurisdictions and topics by clicking the Clear All button.

Categories

About the Category Topics

The Categories section contains multiple subsections: Cross Reference Tables EPC, IP Legislation, IP Conventions, Jurisdictions, Landmark European Patent Cases, and Landmark European Copyright Cases.

All categories can be accessed from their respective links in the Categories section near the top-middle of the home page and from the Categories tab on the top tab menu on all of the pages.

Cross Reference Tables European Patent Convention (EPC)

Cross Reference Tables European Patent Convention is available in the IP Law and Patent Law services. The procedure described below applies to both services.

To browse for Cross Reference Tables European Patent Convention (EPC)

- 1. Select in the Categories section or the Categories tab the Cross Reference Tables EPC link. The Cross Reference Tables EPC page will display.
- 2. Click a table link to view the selected table. The selected cross reference table will display.
- 3. Click an article. The article will display in a separate page.

IP Legislation

IP Legislation is available in all the four services of the Kluwer IP Law service. The procedure described below applies to all four services. To browse for IP Legislation

- 1. Select in the Categories section or the Categories tab the IP Legislation link. The IP Legislation page will display.
- Select the relevant jurisdiction link from the Jurisdictions drop-down or under Choose a Jurisdiction box. The legislation documents related to the selected jurisdiction will display
- 3. Click a legislation document link to view the complete contents of the selected document.

Note: You may click Back button at the bottom left to return to the previous screen.

IP Conventions

IP Conventions is available in all the four services of Kluwer IP Law. The procedure described below applies to all four services.

To browse for IP Conventions

- 1. Select in the Categories section or the Categories tab the IP Convention link. The IP Conventions page will display.
- 2. Click the relevant convention link from the list. The documents related to the selected convention will display.
- 3. Click a document link to view the complete contents of the selected document.

Note: You may click Back button at the bottom left to return to the previous screen.

Jurisdictions

Jurisdictions is available in all the four services of the Kluwer IP Law website. The procedure described below applies to all four services. To browse for Jurisdictions

- 1. Select in the Categories section or the Categories tab the Jurisdictions link. The Jurisdictions page will display.
- Select the relevant jurisdiction from the Jurisdictions drop-down or click a link under Choose a Jurisdiction box. The documents related to the selected jurisdiction will display. By default the general tab is active but you can select one of the other text type tabs to get a list of related documents.

Note: You may click Back button at the bottom left to return to the previous screen.

Landmark European Patent Cases

Landmark European Patent Cases is available in the IP Law and Patent Law services. The procedure described below applies to both services. To browse for Kluwer Patent Cases

- 1. Select in the Categories section or the **Categories** tab the Landmark European Patent Cases link. The Landmark Patent Cases page will display.
- 2. Click a link either under Browse by Jurisdiction heading or under Browse by Topic heading. The documents list related to the selected jurisdiction/selected topic will display.
- Note: The click here link under Information heading links to About Us page of the service.
- 3. Click a document link from the list to view the complete contents of the selected document.

Note: You may click the Back button at the bottom left to return to the previous screen.

Landmark European Copyright Cases

Landmark European Copyright Cases is available in the IP Law and Copyright-Trademark services. The procedure described below applies to both services.

To browse for Kluwer Copyright Cases

- 1. Select in the Categories section or the Categories tab the Landmark European Copyright Cases link. The Landmark Trademark and Copyright Cases page will display.
- 2. Click a link either under Browse by Jurisdiction heading or under Browse by Topic heading. The documents list related to the selected jurisdiction/selected topic will display.

Note: The click here link under Information heading links to About Us page of the service.

3. Click a document link from the list to view the complete contents of the selected document.

Note: You may click the Back button at the bottom left to return to the previous screen.

Books

About the Books Topic Category

The Kluwer IP Law virtual library includes a wealth of authoritative publications. The Books sub-section is available in all four services of the website. The procedure described below is applicable for all four services.

To browse for Books

- 1. Click Books tab. The Books page will display.
- 2. Sort the title list by Title, Author, or Year.
- Click a title link. The selected title will display as a document list, providing page range, author and title for all the documents related to the selected book.
- 4. Click a document link. The selected document will display.

Journals

About the Journals Topic Category

Journals contain different volumes of EPI Information and are available in the IP Law and Patent Law services. The procedure described below applies to both services.

To browse EPI information

- 1. Click Journals from the top tab menu. The Select Journal page will display.
- Click EPI Information link. A new page will open in the same screen. The page displays a list of volumes for a variety of journals. You can collapse/expand the list of volumes by clicking the minus/plus sign or the Collapse All/Expand All links.
- 3. Click a volume link. The selected volume will display with a list of issues. You can collapse/expand the list of issues by clicking the minus/plus sign
- 4. Expand the issue you would like to view by clicking the link. The document list will display for the selected issue.
- 5. Click a document link. The selected document will display.

- 2. Click a document link. The selected document will display in a separate browser window.

The News section in each service lists materials added recently to a particular service.

To browse for News:

Locate the News section on the home page to view a list of materials added recently to a particular service. To view all of the materials in the News section, click the **All News** tab located in the top menu tab. Each page lists a fixed number of news items along with publishing date. To view a news item, click the link below the publishing date. The complete news item will display on a separate page in the same screen.

Books/Journals/Updates

About Books/Journals/Updates

The updates section in each service lists the materials related to that service only. For instance, if you are logged in to IP Law service, it will list materials related to the IP Law service.

Note: The procedure below is for IP Law. The procedure is the same for the other three services unless otherwise noted. **To browse for Updates:**

Click the Updates tab located on the middle of the IP Law home page. The recently added materials to the IP Law will display below the Updates tab.

The News Alert service keeps you informed of the latest developments related to patents, copyrights, trademarks across the world., It includes updates on new laws and changing regulations relevant to intellectual property laws.
